



6th EuroPris Conference and Annual General Meeting

19 June 2017, Lillestrøm, Norway

PRACTICAL INFORMATION

DATE AND VENUE: EuroPris Conference and Annual General Meeting will take place at the Norwegian Correctional Service headquarters in Lillestrøm, Norway, starting at 9 a.m. until 5 30 p.m. on Monday 19th June 2017.

WORKING LANGUAGES: The working languages of the Conference will be English.

REGISTRATION: The EuroPris Conference is open to all interested parties. AGM is for invited participants only. Each participant in the Conference has to register using the online registration form available on the EuroPris website: http://www.europris.org/agm-5/

WORKING DOCUMENTS: all working documents for the Conference will be posted on the Conference website which will be regularly updated. Please note that no working documents will be printed out and distributed during the Conference.

ACCOMMODATION: a restricted number of rooms have been pre-booked at Thon Hotel Arena Lillestrøm for 3 nights (18, 19 and 20 June 2017); participants are invited to reserve their room at their earliest convenience by using the specially provided links: http://conta.cc/2naqOhY

A WELCOME RECEPTION will be held on Sunday 18th June, at 7 p.m., in the canteen to the Norwegian Correctional Service building. The reception will be hosted by Director General Marianne Vollan.

TRANSPORT:

At Oslo airport, Gardermoen

There will be an information desk in the arrivals hall in <u>Oslo airport</u> to direct participants to the railway station at the airport to reach Lillestrøm. You can travel by air train (http://flytoget_eng/) or by local train which is a cheaper alternative (https://www.nsb.no/en/frontpage).

Another information desk will be posted at the Lillestrøm railway station. Lillestrøm is a small town easily accessible by train from the Oslo airport and can be reached within 12 minutes.

VISAS: participants are invited to check at The Norwegian Directorate of Immigration's webpage (https://www.udi.no/en/want-to-apply/) if they need a visa for their visit to Norway. Participants who do need a visa should request a support letter for their visa from the Secretariat of the Council of Europe by filling in this form. Please note that you will still need to follow the procedure indicated by the Norwegian Consulate in your country.

CURRENCY EXCHANGE: there are currency exchanges at Oslo airport Gardermoen, in the departure hall and upon arrival. The airport also has a number of cash dispensers (ATMs). An ATM is also located at Lillestrøm railway station. Opening hours are from 3.45 am to 2 am.).

Electric appliances: The electric current in Norway is 230 Volts. The power sockets are of type F.

Emergency numbers in Norway

The emergency number for **police** is **112**, fire is **110** and ambulance is **113**. Police in Norway: the non-emergency number is **+47 02800**.

If your passport has been stolen, contact your embassy immediately for instructions as to what to do next. You generally need to make a statement at a police station to start any kind of official procedure (insurance, applying for a new passport etc.).

Health emergencies in Norway

- Calling an ambulance
 In emergency medical situations you can call an ambulance. You can also visit the local emergency room for acute illness or injury. For non-threatening issues, you should first contact your local doctor or find your closest out-of-hours medical clinic.
