WHAT IS IT?

The project “Innovation, Development and Communication for a better education in the Prison System” (IDECOM) is a strategic partnership for adult education, financed by the European Commission, through Erasmus+ program. IDECOM project is set on developing and implementing new educational methods in the training of prison staff, addressing transversal skills such as: communication, teamwork competences, ICT, innovation and entrepreneurship.

We welcome you to the IDECOM’s learning management system portal, a web-based and open source tool that will support training courses implementation, and allow prison staff to test and develop those key personal competencies. It is based on a Chamilo platform, and is available in four different European languages: English (European), Romanian (Romania and Moldavia), Portuguese, and Turkish.

Chamilo platform also offers you the possibility of regularly adding new learning modules, thus continuously renewing and improving your experience as a user.

HOW DO YOU KNOW THIS IS FOR YOU?

This platform is intended for prison staff, both those that are currently working in prisons, and those that are initiating career or intend to train to be prison staff. It’s directed at prison staff in different categories, functions and levels:

- Top and middle management (board, legal counselling, economics, health department, logistics, and operations)
- Reintegration and education staff
- Prison Guards
- Teachers and trainers
- Administrative and assistants

WHAT IS THERE TO GAIN WITH IT?

IDECOM’s Learning management system provides you with a simple, clear and coherent learning path in four different languages (English, Romanian,

Portuguese and Turkish), which is based on the development of key skills. You will have access to:

- 1) A self-assessment tool that allows you to measure the level of project targeted skills, while offering you potential solutions to learning needs;
- 2) A diversity of learning modules integrated into a B-learning system of education, allowing you to work and develop the previously assessed skills.

WHICH TRAINING COURSES WILL YOU FIND?

In this blended-learning platform, you will be able to find the following training course curriculum and program's:

- "Develop prison staff's innovation": the "innovation" skill will be targeted. This involves the process of creating new ideas, approaches or instruments to tackle a specific need or problem, utilizing a variety of methodologies and instruments.

- "Entrepreneurship for prison staff": "the entrepreneurship" skill will be addressed, specifically, the process of identifying a need, proactively creating a solution for it, and implementing it through mobilization of resources.

- "Communication, ICT and Teamwork competencies in prison": the "Communication", "ICT" and "Teamwork" skills will be conjointly targeted. Communication involves the ability to express ideas effectively, both verbally and in writing, in individual or group situations, adjusting language, terminology and non-verbal communication in an appropriate manner, resulting in understanding action; ICT consists of knowledge and ability to use and take advantage of information and communication technologies; finally, teamwork implies abilities in working cohesively with others in a shared task, supporting others in order to combine individual strengths into a better team performance.
