Vaccination will be optional, and as it is part of the state health care services – prisoners will receive it for free.				
England and Wales	Due to the principle of equivalence of healthcare, prisoners will receive the vaccine according to the same policy as that applied to the general population. That policy is recommended by a Joint Committee on Vaccination and Immunisation and agreed by our Department						
	for Health and Social Care. Prisoners will not be treated any differently and will access the vaccine according to which priority group they fall into.						
Lithuania	The Lithuanian prison service is waiting for the recommendations from the Ministry of Health. Anyway, inmates will be vaccinated on the same terms as the general population depending on which priority group they fall under (ageing, vulnerable, etc.)						
Sweden	From the S	From the Swedish Prison and Probation Service, SPPS, the response is the same as from HMPPS and the LPD, The prisoners will receive the vaccine according to the same regulations as the general population.
