# *Recommendations of relevance*

*Article 6: National authorities shall endeavour to provide sufficient resources to State agencies and civil society organisations.*

*Art 7: training on child-related policies and practices should be provided for all staff in contact with children.*

*Art 19. Accompany a child's visit.*

*Art 41-42 Sentence planning in order to promote positive parenting and getting ready to leave prison.*

*Art 44, 49 Leaving prison- the need of a multi-agency approach*

# General remarks

- Build interfaces between the authority and civil society - important for families on the outside and for clients on release
- Offer support after the sentence to the entire family.
- Organize support for the child and the family on the outside.
- Lobbying and raise awareness in society about the consequences that imprisonment can have on affected families.
- Challenges- security regulations and permanent funding.
- The road to succès- social contacts with sufficient resources.
- The report shows that the Prison service depend heavily on the NGOs- to maintain the relationship between prisoners and their children.
- Cooperation with NGOs- a way to implement the Recommendations.
