



Smart Prison: Digital Environment for Rehabilitation

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Digital Rights: Imprisonment & Remand Imprisonment Act 2015

- Prisoners may be given permission to send and receive e-mail messages and use the internet for an important reason related to the maintenance of outside contacts, subsistence, or attendance to work-related, educational, judicial, social or housing matters or for another corresponding important reason
- Prisoners may be given permission to communicate with their close relatives or other close persons via video connection or other suitable technical means of communication where the participants have an audio and visual connection with each other. In order to maintain outside contacts or for another important reason, prisoners may be allowed to communicate with some other important person in this manner.

Digital Services Support Strategical Targets

- Reduce recidivism and reintegrate into society
 - Principle of normality: availability of public services
 - More services with personal and easy access
 - Continuum to digital society
 - Prevent marginalisation: digital skills are needed in modern society
 - Modern job market requirements
- Smooth operational and management processes
 - Independent use of services
 - Less paper work: more time for face-to-face contact
 - More productive use of staff resources





Targets of the Smart Prison Project

Hämeenlinna Smart Prison

- Personal cell device in every cell for 100 women inmates
- Smart system (including inmate e-mail in 2022)
- Pilot environment for new digital services
- Digital services as part of everyday management, rehabilitation and interaction between staff and prisoners
- General digital development
 - Digital services portal for joint use workstations enabling new digital services
 - Digital guidance training to staff
 - Meeting the challenges of covid-19!





Targets of the Prison Concept

Prison concept

- Cut costs and uses space more efficiently
- Enable more open prison environment
- Increase prisoners' rehabilitative independence
- Leave more time for interaction and coaching
- Require a new type of a work and management culture

... supported by digital services

- Digital services are cost-effective
- Cell device is a secure access to outside
- Online independent rehabilitation services and studies
- Routine tasks can be managed independently with the cell device
- Change in prison culture enables positive change in prisoners







In a Digital Learning Environment Prisoners...

- Manage their daily affairs via the cell device
- Study also independently and subjects not available in prison
- Contact their relatives online
- **Consult** professionals and take responsibility for their rehabilitation
- Learn digital skills
- Learn to search for information online
- Improve their free time with meaningful activities when in their cells
- Stay on track what happens inside and outside the prison
- Learn VR-assisted self-regulation





In a Digital Learning Environment Staff...

- Benefit from more flexible work flows
- **Contact** prisoners more proactively face-to-face
- Interact with prisoners in new ways online
- Supervice digitally
- Learn digital skills
- Guide prisoners to use digital services
- Adopt values and attitudes supporting
 - New prison concept
 - New prison officer concept including both security and rehabilitative work

Concrete steps to ensure adequate information security and data protection

- Challenge: The target group has tendency to test the security resilience of the system in all possible ways.
- Procurement process
- Adequate resources and key roles in the project team
- Data protection and information security by design and default
- Authentication, controlling, monitoring
- Information security audits
 - Web application
 - Workstation
 - Inmate email system
 - Critical question: What happens after the deployment? How to ensure continuous monitoring?
- DPIA (Data Protection Impact Assessment)
- Training staff and inmates

Aggredissa käyminen on vapaaehtoista ja edellyttää vain halua tehdä asiat tulevaisuudessa toisin, jotta vankilatuomioita el enää tulisi.

Aggredi toimii Helsingissä, Kuopiossa, Porissa, Tampereella ja Turussa. Lahdessa toimintaa ollaan käynnistämässä kesäkuussa 2021.

Vanajan ja Hämeenlinnan vankiloiden kanssa on sovittu yhteistyöstä, joka mahdollistaa työskentelyn aloittamisen videopuheluilla.

Virtual Reality (VR) Assisted Rehabilitation



- Sessions assisted by psychologists
- In collaboration with Tampere Univeristy
 - Relaxation, mood, skills training
 - Substance rehabilitation?
- New VR-programs for social anxiety and aggressiveness in 2022



Training AI

- Training AI algorithms as prison work in four prisons including Smart Prison Hämeenlinna (women inmates)
- In collaboration with a software company
- Training material includes text material on real estates
- Prisoners learn digital and cognitive skills
- Alternative work form to prisoners unable to participate in more physical or group work





Survey to Prisoners

- 74 % uses daily, 100 % every week
- 95 % easy to use
- 84 % fast enough answer to requests and messages
- 95 % got enough help to use the system
- Most used: Requests, video calls, open office tools, material bank, e- and audiobooks, online canteen, online bank etc.
- Wishes: more possibilities for studying and streamed material (news, music etc.)
- Positive: fast and flexible contact to staff, video calls to relatives
- Negative: connection problems especially during video calls
- Grade point average (4-10): 8.1





Survey to Staff

- 42 % uses daily, 42 % weekly, 10 % not at all
- 89 % easy to use
- 86 % easy to answer to prisoners' messages and requests
- 87 % got enough help to use the system
- Positive: fast and realtime communication, video calls are easy to supervise remotely, management of ward's schedules, all important material is reachable in material bank, possibility to contact prisoners when working home, sentence planning interviews and contact to NGO's via video calls
- Negative: more digital work = less face-to-face work?, connectivity problems and "slowness" of the system from time to time, not all prisoners follow messages etc. in the system
