# WHAT IS IT ABOUT?

The Post-Release Support Service is defined as a program in which professionals offer support in the process of transiting back into the community, to people in an exceptionally vulnerable state, due to a lack of social network. Global supervision and support in building a new itinerary of life out of prison begins, through the creation of a stronger and more solid social and environmental link, to prevent them from relapsing into criminal activity.


## WHY IS IT NECESSARY?

3 of every 5 inmates (60%) are released without a progressive transition into the community, and also without professional supervision. It's necessary to think about new systems and programs that work on reducing the risk of recidivism



# In Catalonia 60% of the people are released without a transition plan to the community

- PEOPLE WHO ARE RELEASED IN 2ND DEGREE
- PEOPLE WHO ARE RELEASED IN OTHER SITUATIONS




The recidivism index in Catalonia is of 30%. 7 out of 10 released inmates don't re-offend.

**Of those who offend, 65% do in their first year and 87% during the second year, after being released from prison.**



# HOW DO WE MAKE IT REAL?

**Three months before the inmate is released, those people who fit the profile are referred from the professionals in the penitentiary center.**


**Then the intervention starts. An intervention plan is created with the knowledge and participation of the subject and a “contract” is signed offering a collaborative intervention of 8 months.**

**Once the person is released, a global supervision and support plan begin, building a new itinerary of life out of prison.**

**In PSS we coordinate with their future social and environmental network (social services, families and health centers).**

Duration: 8 months after the release


